Head Coach

Chris Britt has been Head Coach of RSC since 2008, and has led the coaching team during the most successful years in the club's history.

Through a comprehensive school-club link programme, Chris and the coaching team were able to bring to the club numerous talented young swimmers who quickly helped the club towards success. Several have since progressed to National level competition, including Issy Griffiths who has won medals at the ASA National Championships and the British Championships.

Seven years on and Redditch SC is well established as one of the top clubs, not only in Worcester County, but also in the West Midlands – punching well above our weight, for a relatively small club. The club's successes have included winning our first ever Worcester Winter League trophy in 2013, reaching three Division 1 finals in the Nuneaton and District Junior League ('Diddy League') and competing in two finals of the National Arena League (West Midlands) Premier Division; as well as sending record numbers of swimmers to Counties, Midlands and Nationals. As well as Issy Griffiths, other RSC swimmers who have qualified for Nationals during the past seven years have included Paul Wilkes (who set a new British Masters record for the 200 fly in 2014), Abby Humphreys, Dan Ruckwood, Lucy Corden, Sophie Bridgman, Braiden Hartles, Caitlin Britt, Poppy McGourlay, Megan Moss and Tom Page.

As a result of these successes, we are also attracting swimmers from other clubs across a wide area.

Official recognition of Chris's work as RSC Head Coach has included a Coach of the Year award at the Redditch Sports Awards, and nomination for the Herefordshire and Worcesterhire Sports Partnership's Coach of the Year award.
